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• The last 4 months have been extremely challenging. Between the COVID temporary lay-offs and the permanent lay-offs and reductions due to the budget it has been a lot of bad news. We have had several members recalled from temporary lay-offs and are expectant that the majority will be recalled for January 2021. I have also talked to many of our members about the work load with all of the changes. The workload does not seem to have diminished even though our work force has. Please make sure that you are only working the hours you are paid for. We will not see our hours and staff come back if the work is still getting done. Please ensure that you are taking your breaks and not working over your hours if you are not being compensated. If you notice that you are being asked to do different work make sure that you document it and have it added to your JIQ if it is not a one off. We need to make sure that we are being adequately compensated for the work that we are doing. It has been a difficult last 4 months but we are still fighting the good fight.
